Currently my practice is limited to the diagnosis and treatment of pain with Interventional and other medical, acupuncture, or alternative methods. Physical and Occupational Therapy; Psychotherapy; Chiropractic; Psychotherapy; Orthopedic and Neurosurgery is out-sourced to local practices as a virtual "Pain Clinic without Walls"

In NY interventional procedures are done at either a licensed surgical center or in a private office setting both using fluoroscopic guidance.

Both Locations have in office capability to perform fluoroscopically guided interventional pain management procedures (i.e. epidurals, facet and sympathetic blocks; spinal diagnostics (cervical and lumbar discography) and minimally invasive spinal procedures such as Nucleoplasty (Disc Decompression), IDET, Radiofrequency Lesions, Spinal Cord Stimulator Trials.
